CHECKLIST

Kitchen

- Clean out the disposal.
- Turn off and unplug appliances.
- Toss perishable foods from the pantry.
- Empty and clean the refrigerator, and prop the door open.

Living Room

- Pull furniture away from the walls.
- Pull out loose cushions on couches and chairs.
- Clean ashes out of the fireplace and close the chimney flue.

Bedroom

- Strip and clean the bedsheets.
- Leave closet doors and dresser drawers open.

Laundry Room

- Make sure there's no water left in your washing machine.
 Disconnect the hoses to your washer and dryer, and unplug them.

Bathroom

- Clean shower drains.
- Shut off the water supply under each toilet tank and flush to drain the water, or add non-toxic antifreeze rated for plumbing systems to the tank and toilet bowl.
- Pour half a cup of chlorine bleach into the toilet bowl to prevent stain-causing bacteria.

Throughout the House

- Empty trashcans.
- Clean the whole house thoroughly.

Cover furniture with dust covers.

- Leave containers of baking soda, charcoal or cat litter around the house to absorb
- odors and moisture in the air.

Unplug appliances, electronics and anything non-essential.

Energy Efficient Tips

- □ Set the thermostat to 50 degrees for heat and 80 degrees for air conditioning.
- □ Change air and furnace filters.

Close shades and curtains.
